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26. School infrastructure and teachers for examinations conducted by the board and evaluation of answer sheets should be made available as per rule no. 13.4.
27. Running of classes of coaching institutions in the school premises in the pretext of providing coaching to the students for various examinations is not approved by the board. Strict action would be taken on defaulters.
28. As per rule no. 8.7 and 13.11, facilities for physically-challenged student should be adequately provided and every school will ensure inclusion of student with disability/special needs in the school as per provisions of the 'Persons with Disabilities Act 1995'.
29. Health, sanitation and fire safety should be adequately equipped as per rule no. 3.5 (vi), rule 8.5 and rule 23.11.
30. As per rule no. 8.8 (v & vi) every affiliated school to develop their own website containing comprehensive information such as affiliation status, details of infrastructure, details of teachers, number of students, address postal and e-mail telephone nos. etc.
31. As per rule no. 3.2 (iv), every school should organise at least one week training programme for teachers every year in association with any teachers training institute recognised by the State or Central Government or by any agency identified by the Board.
32. Every secondary and senior secondary school will appoint a person on full time basis for performing the duties of Health/Wellness teacher as per rule 8.8.5.
33. Adherence to the provisions of Wild Life Protection Act while procuring plants and animals for the school laboratories by the school must be made known through UD dated 21 May 2013.
34. As per rule 15.1 (3), the school will follow the syllabus on the basis of curriculum prescribed by NCERT/CBSE and textbooks publishing by NCERT/CBSE for the Middle classes as far as practicable or exercise extreme care while selecting books of private publishers. The content must be scrutiny to produce any objectionable content hurting the feelings of any class, community, gender religious group in society. If found prescribed books having such content, the school will have to take responsibility of such content. Provided that the school would put a list of such books prescribed by it on its website with the declaration duly signed by the Manager and the principal to the effect that they have gone through the contents of the books prescribed by the school and own its responsibility.
35. As per RTE act 2009 and Chapter IX rule No. 63.2 (2a) and 63.3, a teacher appointed to teach Class V and VI to VIII should pass in the Central Teacher Eligibility Test (CTET)/ State Teacher Eligibility Test (TET) conducted by the appropriate Government in accordance with the guidelines framed by the NCTE for the purpose.
36. The school should keep a copy of Affiliation Examination Bye Laws for reference purpose and also visited CBSE website [www.cbseaffn.in](http://www.cbseaffn.in) & [www.cbseaffn.in](http://www.cbseaffn.in) for updates.
37. Composition of members as below the rank of Principal of Fr. Secondary School affiliated with the Board be recommended. At least two of them may be approved by the Board as its nominees in the School Managing Committee. Of these 2-3 may be Principals of KVAFSU.
38. The school will create Reserve Fund as per the requirement of the Affiliation Bye Laws.
39. It is mandatory for every affiliated school to become a member in the local Sahodaya of CBSE schools.
40. The Board will not allow any transfer of property/sale of school by one society/ Management Trust to another Society/Management Trust through agreement/sale deed and the school shall not be closed down. In the same premises, in case such transaction is effected expressly or implicitly the Board shall withdraw its affiliation with immediate effect.
41. The school should not start Class X/XII without written approval of the Board. The Board shall not be responsible for any consequences in case class X/XII is started without following the Affiliation Bye Laws and obtaining the prior approval of the Board.
42. The school will apply for further Extension of Provisional Affiliation 'on or before' through [www.cbseaffn.in](http://www.cbseaffn.in) with the prescribed fee of Rs. 25,000/- and other essential documents before 30<sup>th</sup> June of the preceding year before the expiry of the date of provisional affiliation otherwise penalty @ Rs 10,000/- p.m. subject to maximum Rs 60,000/- will be charged for late execution of application.
43. The school will open CBSE pattern classes IX w.e.f. 01.04.2017. Accordingly, the batch of class X of the school will be appeared in the Board Examination to be held in the year 2019.



45. Special conditions to be complied within three months positively failing which the school is liable for action:-

a. The school is required to appoint Special Educator as per rule 13(11) of Affiliation Byelaws of the Board and as mentioned in Board's circular dated 25.06.2015.

46. In case of established violation of Affiliation Bye laws and any of the above mentioned conditions by any school, the school would be liable for deaffiliation under Chapter V, Rule No. 17 of Affiliation Bye-laws.

47. "The society shall enter into a legal agreement with the Board detailing the Board terms and conditions for grant of Affiliation which will be binding on both the parties".
